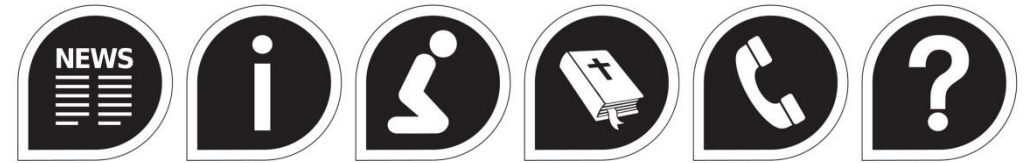
Next prayer meeting 25th November.
